Undergraduate research in the department takes the form of guided study and/or independent research courses taken with a faculty member. These courses can be taken for variable credit (between .25 - 1 course units a semester) and have a minimum GPA requirement of 3.0.

Both this form and faculty availability will be taken into account to determine your potential placement. If a faculty member you list is available, s/he will contact you to begin discussing a possible research plan by **April 17, 2019**. Please note that completion of this form does not guarantee you will be placed with any of the faculty you list as many factors determine how many students, if any, a faculty member can conduct research with.
